Nemea is a town in the prefecture of Corinth and is situated 42 kilometers southwest of Corinth. The Nemea region is known for its wines and wineries. Nemea previously, called Agios Georgios from its Byzantine church, is, however, mostly known for its ancient city and stadium where one of the four Panhellenique sporting events of ancient Greece, the Nemean games, was taking place. The other three were the Pythia, the Isthmia and the Olympic games.
