

PARNON

Parnon is a mountain of 1940 meters height, separating the prefecture of Laconia from the one of Arcadia. Its end, in Laconia, is called Cape Malea or Kavomalias . The inhabitants of Parnon, moved after the second world war down to the village of Ellos to work. Today the villages of the Mountain are deserted and life comes back only during the summer months. The Holy Monastery of Panagia Elona connects Ellos to Parnon, in fact the name of the Monastery derives from the name of the village.

Parnon has several peaks with an altitude of above 1700 meters, such as Psari, Prophet Elias, Gaitanorrachi and Korompilia as well as the lower one of Koulohera.
