VLAHOKERASSIA

The village of Vlahokerassia, is situated at the Arcadian part of Peloponnesus, 22 km from the city of Tripoli, at an altitude of 960 meters. Full of cherry, apple, chestnut, walnut trees, sycamores and running waters, the village was always inhabited.

The ancient inhabitants, the Skyrites, were well known warriors, as all the rest of the Arcadians. The rich findings of the archaeological research are hosted at the Museum of Tegea. The area was the territory of Goddess Demeter, probably because of its very fertile land. Today's lively village, with its well-kept streets, its stone houses and its square with the Church of the Assumption welcomes the visitor with love and care.
