

Skoteini

It is a small mountain village 57 kilometres southwest of the town of Argos in the Peloponnese, southern Greece, and sits at an altitude of 690 meters above sea level. Its name derives from the Greek word for "darkness". It is one of the most beautiful landscapes of Argolida County. It holds a key post, as it is a passage of all three counties (Argolida, Arcadia, and Corinthia). Skoteini was gradually built in three locations and it is now situated upon two mountainsides.
